

Work re-entry plan

PARENTS, carers and the mature-aged can re-enter the workforce more quickly and efficiently thanks to a new initiative being offered by Sarina Russo Job Access in Logan Central.

Manager of Sarina Russo Job Access Logan Central, Michael Leistner, said the Employment Preparation initiative helps jobseekers returning to the workforce after a long absence or to enter work for the first time.

Employment Preparation is free and helps people

improve their prospects for finding work by offering flexible help, tailored to meet their individual needs.

To be eligible jobseekers need to be looking for paid work, been out of the workforce for two years, be a parent or carer or a person aged over 50 years.

Help provided to jobseekers includes an assessment of skills, training to update skills, advice on the local labour market, career counselling, motivational and personal

development training, renewing professional membership fees, support and mentoring and ancillary help such as finding child care.

“I encourage anybody looking for work . . . to register at our Logan Central office and let our specialist consultants assist them in developing the right skills, provide ongoing support and confidence to make them job-ready,” Mr Leistner said.
